

KeyKeg announces double technology breakthrough in one-way keg market

The KeyKeg consortium, inventors and producers of the successful KeyKeg one-way keg, today announces two new product developments and breakthroughs for the one-way keg market. The consortium introduces the KeyKeg disposable dispensing line and the first three KeyKeg beer and wine cooler dispensers to accommodate the new disposable dispensing line. These new product developments will be available on the market immediately after the Brau 2008. With these product developments, the KeyKeg consortium offers the next major improvements in costs, ease of dispensing and contamination risk reduction wherever hygiene is a “none” item.

KeyKeg disposable dispensing beer line

With the introduction of the KeyKeg disposable dispensing line, a brewery can ensure a perfect beer at any time, even in places where the bartender prefers to forget the cleaning of the lines. Because of the improved hygiene, the quality of the beer or wine dispensed will be ensured with the disposable dispensing line. In addition, the special design of the disposable dispensing line will result, together with the KeyKeg, in much easier dispensing compared to conventional dispensing systems. The disposable dispensing line is made of polypropylene and is 1.80 meters long. KeyKegs can be delivered together with the disposable dispensing line on demand as of today.

KeyKeg cooling and dispensing systems

The KeyKeg consortium today announces the first beer and wine coolers with dispensing towers that accommodate the disposable dispensing line. The consortium is showing the KeyKeg SK-2s, the KeyKeg SK-2c and the KeyKeg SK-6. The SK-2s and SK-2c are the most compact combinations for cooling and dispensing. The SK-2s can contain two spherical KeyKeg 20s and the SK-2c the two new cylindrical KeyKeg 20s. The cylindrical KeyKegs have been recently developed by the KeyKeg consortium. The SK-6 can hold 6 cylindrical KeyKeg 20s, 4 spherical KeyKeg 20s or combinations of these. Together with the triple beer tower, 3 different beverages can be dispensed from one cooling cabinet, optimizing space in the outlet. The combinations were developed for the catering industry

and outlets with a lower to moderate volume. The new cooler dispensers have been developed by DSI, a member of the KeyKeg consortium and HVM.

KeyKeg beer and wine cooler dispenser

The first KeyKeg beer and wine cooler dispensing towers are produced by DSI and HVM. The photo shows the KeyKeg SK-6, suitable for spherical and cylindrical KeyKegs. The SK-6 can be used for cooling and dispensing 6 cylindrical or 4 spherical KeyKeg 20s. The KeyKeg SK-2s is a smaller unit taking two spherical KeyKeg 20s while the SK-2c is the smallest, taking two cylindrical KeyKeg 20s. The cylindrical KeyKegs will be launched on the market in 2009.

KeyKeg disposable dispensing line

The KeyKeg disposable dispensing line is made of polypropylene. It can be used with every KeyKeg and makes dispensing even easier, more efficient and hygienic in comparison to conventional dispensing systems.
